Deer Park Community Center Afterschool Recreation Program Policy

The Town of Babylon Deer Park Community Center Afterschool Recreation program is intended to be a fun and organized way for children to spend afternoons after school during every regularly scheduled school day – with the exception of, but not limited to, school closing due to holidays or inclement weather and community center sponsored events.

The following criteria MUST be considered and met when determining eligibility for this program:

1. **Age requirement:** Participants are enrolled in grades Kindergarten through 8th grade for the current program year.
2. **Registration requirement:** Each participant must be registered. And have a completed registration form and Authorization to Release form on file in the community center office. Also, a permission letter must be sent to Deer Park School District Transportation office allowing transport from participant's school to the community center. Once the registration requirement is met, you will be notified by the center director with your child's start date.
3. **Program attendance requirement:** Each registrant must be in attendance at the community center at least two (2) days per scheduled school week and for each day of attendance at least one (1) hour after arrival to the community center. The center director MUST be notified by a parent/guardian when a participant will be absent from the program for more than one (1) week. If notice is not provided, the participant may not be permitted to continue in the program.
4. **Program time:** Program ends at 6:00pm. At which time, each participant MUST be picked-up by only the individuals listed on the "Authorization to Release" form. Any registrant picked-up after 6:00pm more than twice *will not* be allowed to continue in the program.
5. **Rules and Regulation requirement:** see below

Rules and Regulations

The Rules and Regulations of the Town of Babylon Deer Park Community Center must be followed by all participants at all times. The Town of Babylon Deer Park Community Center reserves the right to suspend the use of this facility to anyone in violation any of the following toward any staff and/or other participant, and/or any person on this property:

- The use of abusive and/or disrespectful language
 - Displays aggressive and/or violent behaviors
- Willful destruction and/or unauthorized removal of any program property
 - In possession of any weapons or any illegal substance
 - Inappropriate dress (bandanas, gang colors, halter tops, etc.)
