The Church of Scotland Guild is a movement within the Church of Scotland which invites and encourages both women and men to commit their lives to Jesus Christ and enables them to express their faith in worship, prayer and action. With around 23,000 members, the Guild is one of Scotland's largest voluntary organisations.

Although women make up the bulk of the membership, increasingly, men are becoming members and taking roles at local and national levels. The guild's motto which is taken from Acts 27, verse 23 is "Whose we are and Whom we serve."

The Guild meets fortnightly in New St Andrew's on a Wednesday at 7.30pm in the Memorial Chapel. The theme for this year is Go in Love.
