Vendors who choose to have items auctioned at the end of the day a 20% commission will be charged.

Bazaar Rules/Compliances

- It is the vendor's responsibility to know and comply with all applicable Federal and State laws and regulations for the products they sell at the Bazaar, including any required licenses. The Bazaar makes not warranty or endorsement of any vendor's product, and assumes no responsibility for any consequences resulting from the vendor's failure to comply with the laws or regulations applicable to the sale of their product. As a condition to participating in the Bazaar, the vendor shall agree to Indemnify and hold harmless the Bazaar from any damage or injury resulting from their use of the approved area.
- Vendor are responsible for providing any and all tables, chairs and other equipment.
- All vendors must comply with applicable federal and state safety rules and regulations. Vendors who commit a food safety violation resulting in a warning from the Virginia Department of Agriculture and Consumer services will be requested to not return.
- Food vendors who prepare and/or cook food at the bazaar must have a fire extinguisher present at all times.
- Vendors are responsible for setting up his/her stand in an attractive manner and keeping boxes and supplies stored out of sight. All food items must be raised at least 2 feet from the ground. All baked goods must be covered. Vendors are responsible for all equipment and materials required for the display of items. Each vendor shall be solely responsible at all times for the cleanliness around and their vending area regardless of the origin of the debris in that location. The vendor is responsible for leaving the space in a clean

condition at the end of the day. Failure to comply will result in the vendor bearing the cost of any and all clean up that is required.

- Meat products from cattle, swine, goats, poultry, sheep, and rarities are subject to the regulations of the United States Department of Agriculture and/or the Virginia Department of Agriculture and consumer services. Vendors of meat and poultry products must comply with all applicable federal and state food safety regulations pertaining to their products prior to offering them for sale at the bazaar.
- Taxes: Vendors are responsible for filing taxes from sales at the bazaar with the appropriate authority. The bazaar is not responsible for the collection or payment of any applicable sales taxes owned by the vendor.
- Non-Profits: Must provide proof of non-profit status.
- Reserved Spaces: These spaces are only available to those who pay for the full season in advance.
- Unreserved Spaces: Are on a first come first serve basis.
- No more than one vendor per space is permitted.
- The bazaar is not responsible for damage or loss of any personal or other items at the bazaar.
- All vendors are required to have their spaces prepared and ready for customers to the advertised time of the start of the bazaar.
- Vendors understand and assume any and all financial risks of participating at each bazaar. The Bazaar does not guarantee any amount of customers or revenues at the bazaars.
- Management reserves the right to cancel any market day due to inclement weather to ensure vendor and patron safety.

Standards of Conduct

Prohibited:

- Carelessly or willfully causing destruction of market or vendor property.
- Manufacturing, distributing, possessing, using or being under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs during the Bazaar.

- Using obscene language toward fellow vendors, management or customers.
