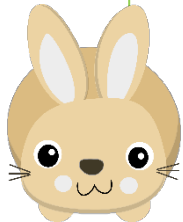

Please remember to bring hats, mittens, and snow pants!

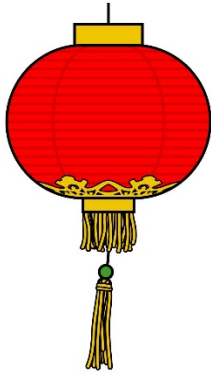
