All children have a 'key person' in preschool. This member of staff has responsibility for tracking progress and development through careful observations and planning of activities. Please ensure you know who your child's key person is and feel free to come in and have a chat with them. The boards in the foyer have our individual planning on so you can see what we are working on with your child.
