The Gratitude Attitude

In a Second Helping of Chicken Soup for the Soul, Rev. John R Ramsey tells how in one church a certain person provided him with a rose boutonniere for the lapel of his suit every Sunday. At first, he really appreciated it but then it, sort of became routine. Then one Sunday it became very special.

As he was leaving the Sunday service a young boy walked up to him and said, "Sir, what are you going to do with your flower?" At first, the preacher didn't know what the boy was talking about. When it sank in, he pointed to the rose on his lapel and asked the boy, "Do you mean this?"

The boy said, "Yes, sir. If you're just going to throw it away, I would like it." The preacher smiled and told him he could have the flower, and then casually asked what he was going to do with it. The boy, who was probably no more than 10 years old, looked up at the preacher and said, "Sir, I'm going to give it to my granny. My mother and father divorced last year. I was living with my mother, but she married again and wanted me to live with my father. I lived with him for a while, but he said I couldn't stay, so he sent me to live with my grandmother. She is so good to me. She cooks for me and takes care of me. She has been so good to me that I wanted to give her that pretty flower for loving me."

When the little boy finished, the preacher could hardly speak. His eyes filled with tears, and he knew he had been touched by God. He reached up and unpinned the rose. With the flower in his hand, he looked at the boy and said, "Son, that is the nicest thing that I've ever heard, but you can't have this flower because to your granny it's not enough. If you'll look in front of the pulpit, you'll see a big bouquet of flowers. Different families buy them for the church each week. Please take those flowers to your granny because she deserves the very best." Then the boy made one last statement which Rev. Ramsey said he will always treasure. The boy said, "What a wonderful day! I asked for one flower but got a beautiful bouquet. "That's the thankful spirit. That's the gratitude attitude. And it's attitude that should guide our giving and our lives. Like that boy's granny, God has blessed us so much.

¡El valor del Silencio!

Las grandes decisiones en la vida nacieron de momentos de silencio.

Necesitamos del silencio para una mayor unificación personal. La mucha distracción produce desintegración y ésta acaba por engendrar desasosiego, tristeza, angustia.

Hay diversas clases de silencio. Jesús nos dijo: "cierra las puertas". Cerrar las puertas y ventanas de madera es fácil. Pero aquí se trata de unas ventanas más sutiles, para conseguir ese silencio.

Está, primero, el silencio exterior, que es más fácil de conseguir: silencio de la lengua, de puertas, de cosas y de personas. Es fácil. Basta subirse a un cerro, internarse en un bosque, entrar en una capilla solitaria, y con eso se consigue silencio exterior.

Pero está, después, el silencio interior: silencio de la mente, recuerdos, fantasías, imaginaciones., memoria, preocupaciones, inquietudes, sentimientos, corazón, afectos. Este silencio interior es más difícil, pero imprescindible para oír a Dios e intimar con Él.

Los enemigos del silencio son la dispersión, el desorden, la distracción, la diversión, la palabrería, la excesiva juerga, risotadas, la velocidad, el frenesí, el ruido.

¿Qué relación hay entre eucaristía y silencio?

El mayor milagro se realiza en el silencio de la eucaristía. Las más íntimas amistades se fraguan en el silencio de la eucaristía. Las más duras batallas se vencen en el silencio de la eucaristía, frente al Sagrario. La lectura de la Palabra que se tiene en la misa debe hacerse en el silencio del alma, si es que queremos oír y entender. El momento de la Consagración tiene que ser un momento fuerte de silencio contemplativo y de adoración. Cuando recibimos en la Comunión a Jesús ¡qué silencio deberíamos hacer en el alma para unirnos a Él! Nadie debería romper ese silencio.

Las decisiones más importantes se han tomado al pie del silencio, junto a Cristo eucaristía. ¡Cuántas lágrimas secretas derramamos en el silencio!
