1. No refunds will be made after confirmation of application, including bad weather. If you are a non-show, your business will not be invited next year.
2. PMRPC reserves the right to decline any application. No duplication of food services. Notification of acceptance of application will be provided within 2 weeks of receiving.
3. After setup is done, vendor vehicle will need to be parked in vendor parking area (before 8:45 am)
4. All Vendors are committing to staying the whole event.
5. Set up on Friday December 15, 2016 pm and continue at 7:30 am on Saturday until 9:00 am (event start time).
6. Vendor shall maintain allocated space and vending unit in a neat, safe, extra clean and orderly condition during the event.
7. Vendor shall furnish trash containers and bags. All bagged garbage can be disposed of in the Roll off Dumpster. That will be provided by the club.
8. A clean up fee of \$75.00 will be billed to any vendor who does not leave their area clean.
9. Sales tax collection and payment will be the exhibitor's responsibility. Please include Sales Tax permit number on your entry application
10. Vendor shall comply with all laws, ordinances, rules and regulations of any lawful authority, agency or government entity which apply to the use of its vending unit requirements, including without limitation, any applicable fire and building codes and health regulations of Brevard County. A copy of Food Handler Permit must be included with applications.
11. No alcoholic beverages allowed.
12. Food Vendors: Please include a copy of your menu with registration.
13. All Vendors must sign and return attached Release and Hold Harmless Agreement before the event and carry an required insurance per state and county requirements.
