Bob was recruited to Cincinnati from St. Louis, where he served as senior vice president for entrepreneurial development at the St. Louis Regional Chamber and Growth Association. Bob came to Cincinnati in 2005, when CincyTech was created in its current form with a \$14.8 million grant from Ohio Third Frontier matched by \$7.5 million from the Cincinnati USA Regional Chamber, the University of Cincinnati and Cincinnati Children's Hospital, and 20 other local organizations. To date, CincyTech has raised over \$67 million in public and private funding, attracted over \$910 million in subsequent rounds of funding and helped CincyTech funded startups create over 1000 jobs in the greater Cincinnati area.

Bob Beech is an inventive CEO, founder, and senior corporate executive with over 25 years of experience leading early to later stage biotech and healthcare IT ventures. Proven ability in multiple dimensions of governance and senior executive leadership, including: commercial and nonprofit boards and advisory councils, CEO management, strategic planning, business development,

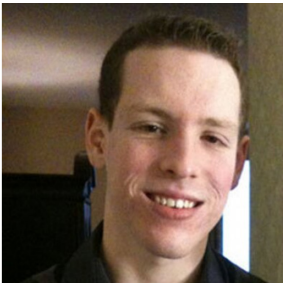

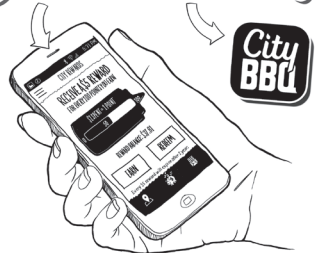
