Whew, it's been a long hot summer, and it's only half over! Not only is it the time to keep our orchids cool, breezy and humid (as if this were not enough), but also time to watch for predators.

I'm sure that Harry and I aren't the only ones to have problems this season with insects. I hope that you have attended your collection more carefully and prevented damage. Some of us are slow learners and some of us spend a lifetime trying to learn! We are here to help each other learn to enjoy growing so I will share some things that we have encountered this year. We have battled scale and finally gotten it under control with products containing imidacloprid. We found red spider mites and are continuing the process of treating with products using permythrin (miticides).

With the thought of 'viruses' in the air I had convinced Harry that almost every plant we had was diseased. We went crazy researching with no concrete answers. Our plants have had twisting with streaked and mottled leaves and brown rot. Well, while reading everything I could find on viruses, I stumbled upon something that I learned last year, concerning calcium and magnesium deficiencies. Continued page 2




The Paph on the right is Moon Stone sent to me by Charles and Judy Rush.
