Directions from Mobile: get on Ziegler Blvd and head west. Ziegler will turn into Tanner Williams Rd at the Coast Guard Aviation Training Center. Continue west on Tanner Williams Road. You will continue through the intersection of Snow Road and cross Big Creek Lake on the dam. The next intersection will be County Rd 5 which is Wilmer Rd. Turn right on Wilmer Rd and our house is 1.5 miles on the right second house past Bryan Graham nursery.

Directions from Wilmer, Al. Turn on County Rd 5 (South) at the traffic light and go 5 miles. The house will be on the left. Second house past Graham nursery (red sign).
