Whereas,

The Student Government Association Senate has a Secretary who is to take record of the meetings and create the minutes. Inaccurate statements come about in the minutes, or are out of context, confusing the reader who is reviewing the minutes prior to a meeting or to discuss the events of a meeting.

Whereas,

The secretary is human and may only be able to summarize the points a Senator makes, sometimes causing the minutes to lack some support due to the lack of ability to take notes at computer speeds.

Whereas,

The secretary needs the time between meetings to translate their notes into the minutes to send out to the Senate for approval.

Whereas,

There are occasionally three (3) microphones allotted for senators to use, and are not available for all to use or are required to use.

Be it enacted that,

The Student Government Association Senate, acting in their official capacity as representatives of the student body of The Catholic University of America, hereby requests microphones, or other audio receivers, to record a Senator's statements and/or comments in a Senate to provide accurate transcripts of the meetings to the Senate so that accurate records may be kept in the archives of the Senate. These transcripts may be used at the discretion of the Student Government Association President and Vice President to clarify points, comments, etc.
