Whereas,

The Undergraduate Student Activity Fee is used to fund programming for all Catholic University student organizations, club sports, and the Office of Campus Ministry.

Whereas,

The Undergraduate Student Activity Fee has not been adjusted to account for inflation or changes to enrollment since 2014.

Whereas,

The current Activity Fee of \$120 per semester is not in line with other Universities of our size and geographic location.

Whereas,

The Student Government Association Treasury Board has expressed that an increase to the Activity Fee would allow for more financial stability and increase funding opportunities for student organizations.

Be it enacted that,

The Student Government Association Senate, acting in its official capacity as the representative of the undergraduate student body of The Catholic University of America, hereby request that the Undergraduate Student Activity Fee be increased by \$8 per semester beginning in fiscal year 2020.
