### Academic Achievement

Another semester, another improvement in chapter GPA! Pictured above is our cumulative chapter and new member GPA's from the Spring Semester, getting a 3.133 house GPA, which ranks 8th among fraternities, and a 2.689 new member GPA, which ranks 13th among fraternities. Compared to our house GPA in the fall of a 3.052, and previous semesters below a 3.0, we can see a steady increase in our house GPA with each new semester. Our goal for the coming semester is to rank in the top 5 among fraternities and get above a 3.2 cumulative.
