

## November 21, 2017 Meeting Minutes Chelsea Heights

### 1. Principal's Report

Conferences Feedback: Conference turnout is at 95% right now. Our goal is 100%. Teachers are working on connecting with all families. Specialists - Signs have been posted reminding families to see specialist teachers. Teachers are really appreciative of the meals. Question/Suggestion for Jill- If you are scheduled for more than one conference and your schedule is back to back, it can be tough to make it to the next one on time. Can we request that we not be scheduled back to back? Please write a note on the conference form if you would like your conferences to not be back to back.

Book Fair had record sales with nearly \$7000, with \$3800 going back to the library. PTO is looking for a Book Fair coordinator for next school year.

Eagle Bluff is Dec. 6-8. We had a lot of parent volunteers. We have our next Awards Assembly coming up in December 12th, and the 5th grade music concert on Dec. 19th. The next Cheetah Challenge is hallway behavior.

Question: Why are the free and reduced lunch forms important to fill out? The more forms we have turned in, the more information Jill has. This gets us better information for Title 1 funding.

### 2. NW Como:

Winter and Spring brochures are out and available and will be sent home in backpacks on Dec. 1st, sign ups beginning Dec. 4th.. The Booster Club is very excited about this opportunity to raise funds and will be coordinating with PTO. NW Como Booster Club is looking for more participants.
