# Service Station Operating Under New Management

Following the sale of the only petrol outlet in Stanhope, operated by Garry and Carol Farrow for many years, the new management re opened the site on Tuesday 26th July for the sale of petrol and diesel.

The new owner, Ravi Babu, who operates a number of similar sites around Australia and is based in Sydney, has appointed Azhar and his wife Sufia as managers of the Stanhope operation. Together with their two year old daughter Rabiya they are now living in the attached residence.

Azhar, who came from India in 2009 has a number of years experience with Service Stations in Gippsland since he arrived in Australia.

He told the "About Town" in an interview, that the new owner intends to make wholesale changes to the Stanhope site by considerable updates of the present buildings and installing the latest technology for the sale of Petrol and Diesel. It is not intended to install an LPG outlet currently. Planning is underway for the installation of a food outlet and the sale of many other products normally found in modern Service Stations.

Following a proposed visit by an architect in the next week or so, upgrading will commence as soon as possible, with plans to have everything completed by the end of this year. Until these modern facilities are installed the business will operate six days per week opening from 8.00 am till 6.00 pm.

#### **Discounted Petrol and Service**

Azhar said it is intended to offer driveway service by serving people with their fuel, if they so wish. He also said they intend to offer discounted fuel similar to another service station in this area. Already, the cost of petrol has been reduced by two cents, compared to petrol stations in nearby towns. He also said they intend to offer customers the opportunity to operate monthly accounts if they wish.

#### Computer servicing

Azhar's wife Sufia, is highly experienced in computer servicing. She said she would be most keen to become involved in servicing computers for the local community. As they are complete strangers to the area, they wish to meet local people and become involved in the Stanhope Community. Drop in and say hello. They can be contacted by phone at 0432 018 367.

## **Fonterra Update**

The level of activity at the Site has increased yet again this month with the following taking place all at once:

- On-going works to build the new cheese factory are on track. Many residents will have noticed the building has rapidly grown in height with 15m wall panels and roofing now being installed.
- The removal of processing equipment and building demolition works have taken place in the old cheese plant (see photos) to make way for reinstatement of walls and a roof over powder processing components of the factory.
- At least 50 contractors are on site in the main factory helping undertake routine maintenance as part of the annual shutdown.

# Farmers encouraged to apply for funding

Young farmers in the Euroa electorate have the opportunity to apply for funding so they are better equipped to face the challenges and opportunities of farming, Member for Euroa and Deputy Leader of the Nationals Steph Ryan said today.

Ms Ryan said scholarships of up to \$10,000 were available to farmers and farmhands under 35 years of age to help their development and improve their career progression.

"Young farmers can access \$5000 for study and a further \$5000 to invest in on-farm or professional development activities to put new skills into practice," Ms Ryan said.

"This is a great opportunity for anyone who is pursuing a career in agriculture and I encourage young farmers from across our region to apply."

Ms Ryan said the scholarship program was designed so it can be flexible to fit in with the demands of farmers and farmhands across the state.

"Some of the courses eligible include human resources training, business management, a Diploma in Agriculture, a Diploma of Agribusiness Management and on-farm technical training," Ms Ryan said.
