WHEREAS; On April 25th, 2017 the DC Council Committee on Education will hold a Budget Oversight Hearing;

WHEREAS; ANC1A has three (3) DC Public Schools representing 24001 students within its boundaries and agrees fully with Mayor Muriel Bowser’s statement, “we value public education, and we know that investments in our schools are really investments in the future of our community”2;

WHEREAS; In July 2016, The Office of the State Superintendent of Education (OSSE) created a Uniform Per Student Funding Formula (UPSFF) Working Group pursuant to section 112(c) of the Uniform Per Student Funding Formula for Public Schools and Public Charter Schools Act of 1998, effective March 26, 1999 (D.C. Law 12-207; D.C. Official Code § 38-2911(c));

WHEREAS; The recommendation of the UPSFF working group was to increase the base rate of the UPSFF by 3.5%, from the FY17 rate of \$9,682 to \$10,021; and

WHEREAS; Mayor Bowser’s FY18 Budget proposes a 1.5% increase to the UPSFF.

BE IT RESOLVED THAT: ANC1A respectfully requests that Councilmember Grosso and the Committee on Education support increasing the FY18 Budget’s UPSFF rate by the 3.5% recommended by OSSE to ensure all schools have the resources they need to enable students to successfully meet DC academic performance standards.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Advisory Neighborhood Commission 1A authorizes Commissioner Christine Miller, ANC 1A05 and Chair of ANC 1A Education Committee, to represent the Commission at the scheduled hearing.
