# L.A. Park Board Moves to Acquire 6.9 Acres for Palms Playground

PALMS—First step in acquiring 6.9 acres at Rose and Overland Aves. for playground purposes has been started by the Los Angeles Recreation and Parks Commission.

Final negotiations for two parcels of land located in the southern part of the tract

are now being conducted, according to A. M. Hill, director of the Los Angeles Bureau of Right-of-Way.

In addition, the commission has instructed the bureau to go ahead with talks to acquire a second Palms park site at Overland Ave. and Dunleer St., known as

the Rainey property.

Formal appraisals of both the proposed park sites have been completed, but the figures will not be released until a future date.

The request for a proposed Palms playground facility came from the Palms Citizens Advisory Committee.
