

BOARD WILL CONSIDER NAME FOR PALMS PARK

PALMS — A proposal to name a site at Overland Ave. and Dunleer St. Palms Pioneer Park will be considered by the City Recreation and Park Commission Thursday.

The 4.57-acre site was recently acquired by the city

for use as a park-playground, a commission spokesman said.

Recommendations Made

Recommendations to name the park-playground Palms Pioneer Park were made by the Palms Chamber of Commerce and Councilman Karl L. Rundberg.

Rundberg also recommended that the name Palms be dropped from the Palms-Mar Vista Playground, thereby giving each community a facility bearing its own name.
