

Commission Studies New Library Plan

WEST LOS ANGELES--

A new plan which places the Rancho Palms Branch Library on the northwest corner of Palms Park is being considered by the Los Angeles Recreation and Park Commission.

The plan, which also calls for the acquisition of additional property adjacent to

the park's northwest corner at 2950 Overland Ave., has been approved by the Board of Library Commissioners.

Originally, the library was planned for the park's southwest corner. However, interfering with the plan is the Santa Monica Freeway, which needs nearby property for offramps.
