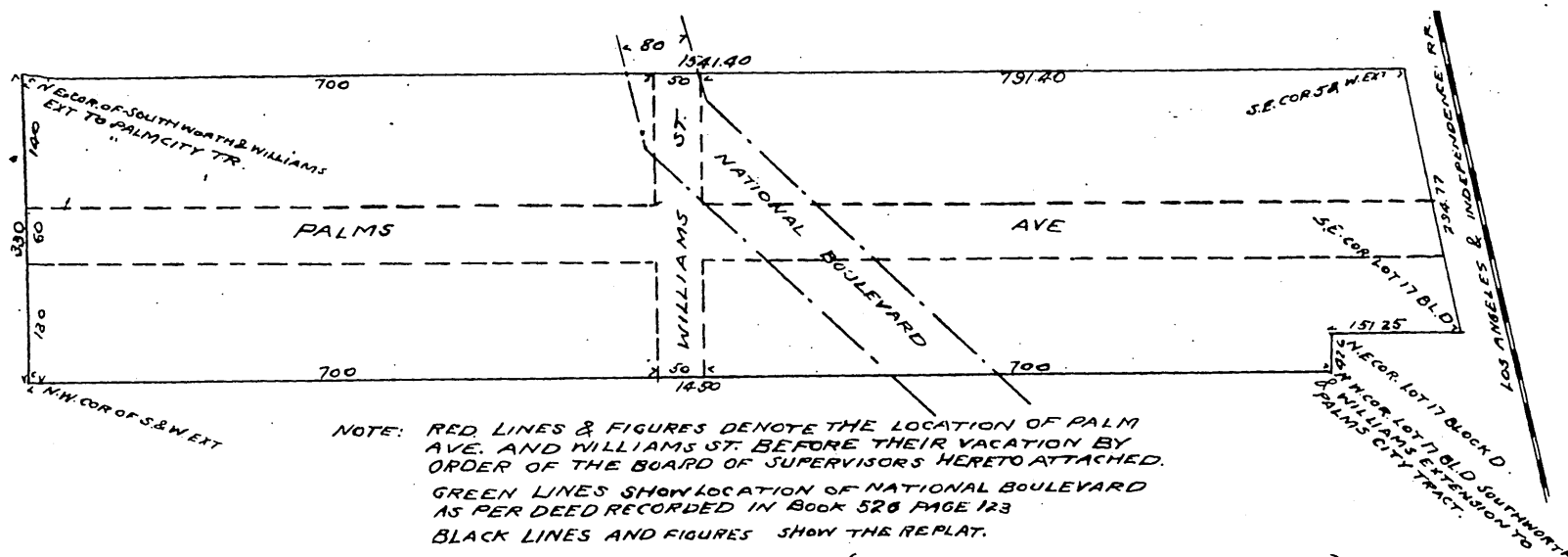


# Replat of a portion of Southworth & Williams' Extension of the Palm City Tract.

In re Vacation of Palms Avenue and Williams Street in Southworth & Williams' Extension to the Palms City Tract.

Upon motion of Supervisor Field, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that the petition be and the same is hereby granted, and it is further ordered that Palms Avenue and Williams Street in the Southworth and Williams Extension to the Palms City Tract, as recorded in Book 22, page 23 - Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County, be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained restored to acreage. And it is further ordered that this order is conditioned upon the filing by the petitioner of a certified copy of this order together with a map showing all property as affected thereby, in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County, California.

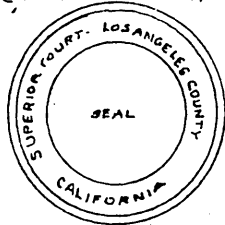
