(Inhabited Territory)

(Under Stats. 1913, P. 587, Act 5159, Deering's General Laws)

By an election held May 31, 1949; Ordinance No. 95004 of the City of Los Angeles, adopted June 7, 1949, approving the annexation; notice filed with the Secretary of State July 20, 1949; affidavit, etc., filed with the County Recorder July 26, 1949, the following described territory was annexed:

Beginning at the northwest corner of Tract No. 13325, as per map recorded in Book 266, Pages 38 to 40 of Maps, Records of Los Angeles County, said point of beginning being a point in the westerly boundary of that certain territory annexed to the City of Los Angeles May 22, 1915, and known as "Palms Addition", and in the boundary of the City of Los Angeles as the same existed June 1, 1948; thence southerly along the boundary of the City of Los Angeles and continuing along said boundary of the City of Los Angeles in all its various courses to the point of beginning.

Dear Sir:

Proceedings for Armas Addition to the City of Los Angeles were filed with the County Recorder and became effective July 26, 1949.

Territory covered by this annexation was automatically withdrawn from Road District No. 4, Los Angeles County Public Library Tax, and Consolidated County Fire Protection District and added to the Metropolitan Water District.

The Livonia Sewer Maintenance District (1927 Act), National Lighting District and Armas Garbage Disposal District all lying within said annexation have been dissolved.

Said territory was withdrawn from the Culver City Unified School District and added to the Los Angeles City School District and the Los Angeles City High School District.

Culver City School District, Annex January 27, 1948 and Los Angeles City High School District Annex January 27, 1948 were eliminated.

The attached map and description of said annexation are forwarded to you for your information and for transmittal to the State Board of Equalization under instructions of the Board of Supervisors of October 30, 1935.

"ARNAZ ADDITION" TO CITY OF LOS ANGELES
SCHOOL DISTRICT HISTORY OF THE AREA:

Jan. 21, 1947
(Effective date
of Culver City
Charter)

One of the three parcels of unincorporated Territory of (old) Culver City School District automatically excluded from Culver City School District (due to adoption of Culver City Charter) and therefore from Los Angeles City High School and Junior College Districts and which ceased to be a part of any school district per County Counsel opinion January 13, 1947 (Letter - Surveyor to Assessor January 29, 1947).

Territory ceased to be liable for any part of outstanding bonded indebtedness of any of above three districts per County Counsel opinion February 11, 1947.

Jan. 27, 1948

Territory annexed to Culver City School District by order of Board of Supervisors under E.C. 2422, and automatically annexed to Los Angeles City High School and Junior College Districts

Territory did not become liable for outstanding bonded indebtedness of any of the three districts per County Counsel opinion January 16, 1948 (oral) and therefore became code area labeled:
"Culver City School District, Annex 1-27-48"
"Los Angeles City High School District, Annex 1-27-48"
and "Los Angeles City Junior College District, Annex 1-27-48" (Letter - Surveyor to Assessor 1-27-48; Boundary Change No. 29, Code Sheet).

Jan. 25, 1949

Culver City High School District formed by order of Board of Supervisors and elementary and high school district merged as Culver City Unified School District (Complete July 1, 1949)

New district continues as part of Los Angeles City Junior College District

Non-liability for bonded indebtedness remains without change and Arnaz territory continues to constitute code area as indicated above. (Letter - Surveyor to Assessor - 1/26/49)

July 26, 1949

Territory automatically transferred from Culver City Unified School District to Los Angeles City School District and Los Angeles City High School District due to "Arnaz Addition" to the City of Los Angeles.

Ordinance No. 95,004

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES OF THAT CERTAIN TERRITORY KNOWN AND DESIGNATED AS "ARNAZ ADDITION."

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of an act of the Legislature of the State of California, entitled "Annexation Act of 1913," approved June 11, 1913, as amended, a special election was duly and regularly held on the 31st day of May, 1949, in that certain territory hereinafter described and known as the "ARNAZ ADDITION," in the County of Los Angeles, contiguous to the City of Los Angeles, and proposed to be annexed to the City of Los Angeles, at which there was submitted to the vote of the qualified electors of said territory proposed to be annexed the question of the proposed annexation of such territory to the City of Los Angeles, the property therein after such annexation to be subject to taxation equally with the property in said City of Los Angeles to pay that certain bonded indebtedness of said City of Los Angeles outstanding at the date of such annexation, and indebtedness theretofore authorized and to be represented by bonds of the City of Los Angeles thereafter to be issued, all as more fully set forth in the Notice of Election, the Ordinance Calling the Election, and in the ballot used at such election; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Los Angeles did, at its meeting of June 6, 1949, canvass the returns of said election with respect to the votes cast for and against said proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, as shown by such canvass a majority of all votes cast at said election were in favor of such annexation; NOW, THEREFORE,

The People of the City of Los Angeles Do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That the annexation to the City of Los Angeles of the hereinafter described, unincorporated territory, known and designated as "ARNAZ ADDITION," under the provisions of that certain Act of the Legislature of the State of California known and designated as the Annexation Act of 1913, approved June 11, 1913, as amended, BE, AND THE SAME IS HEREBY RATIFIED, CONFIRMED AND APPROVED.

The territory so annexed, which said territory is designated as "ARNAZ ADDITION," is contiguous to the City of Los Angeles, and is situated in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, and is more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the northwest corner of Tract No. 13325, as per map recorded in Book 286, Pages 33 to 40 of Maps, Records of Los Angeles County, said point of beginning being a point in the westerly boundary of that certain territory annexed to the City of Los Angeles May 22, 1915, and known as "Palm Addition," and in the boundary of the City of Los Angeles as the same existed June 1, 1915, thence southerly along the boundary of the City of Los Angeles and continuing along said boundary of the City of Los Angeles in all its various courses to the point of beginning.

Sec. 2. That the Clerk of the Council of the City of Los Angeles shall forthwith, upon the taking effect of this ordinance, make and certify under the seal of the City of Los Angeles, and transmit to the Secretary of State of the State of California, a copy of the record of the canvass of returns of the election in such new territory, together with a statement showing the date of the special election in said "ARNAZ ADDITION," the time and the result of the canvass of the returns of such election, and containing a description of such territory, together with a certified copy of this ordinance, giving the date of its passage.

The City Clerk shall also file in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County an affidavit stating that all requirements of the laws pertaining to such proceedings have been complied with, which said affidavit shall be accompanied by a certified copy of the boundary description as set forth in said proceedings, and also by a map delineating such boundaries, pursuant to the requirements of the Statutes of 1939, Chapter 472.

Sec. 3. That, as provided by Section 1 of said Annexation Act of 1913, from and after the date of the filing of the said certified copy of this ordinance and supporting documents in the office of the Secretary of State, as aforesaid, the annexation of such heremaboves described territory known and designated as "ARNAZ ADDITION," shall be deemed to be, and shall be complete, and thenceforth such annexed territory shall be to all intents and purposes a part of the City of Los Angeles, a municipal corporation, and the property within such annexed territory shall be taxed to pay the bonded indebtedness or liabilities of the City of Los Angeles as specified in said Notice of Election, equally with the property within said City of Los Angeles as it existed prior to the filing of such petition for the annexation of said "ARNAZ ADDITION."

Sec. 4. When the annexation of said territory shall be complete, said territory shall be added to and become a part of the Eleventh Councilmanic District of the City of Los Angeles.

Sec. 5. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and cause the same to be published in some daily newspaper printed and published in the City of Los Angeles. Thereby certify that the foregoing ordinance was passed by the Council of the City of Los Angeles, at its meeting of June 7, 1949.
