

Fifty-Thousand-Dollar Old English Home

This home, which its builder, member of a pioneer realty family, calls Terrace View, is an unusually fine example of Elizabethan architecture. The old English style will be carried out even to the interior decorations, according to Mr. Forrester, who personally designed the building. It is of brick, half-timber and plaster construction and contains eighteen rooms and five baths. The house occupies a knoll at 2720 Monte Mar Terrace overlooking the Hillcrest Country Club and is on one of the highest points between the city and the sea. Exclusive of site, the home will cost about \$50,000.
