

Heart Disease Proves Fatal for Attorney

Harry W. McNutt, attorney, yesterday died of heart disease at his home, 735 South Manhattan Place. Mr. McNutt, who was 58 years of age, was born in Cincinnati, was admitted to the bar in Missouri, where he practiced law for ten years, and then came to Los Angeles twenty years ago. During most of his legal career here he was associated with the late Delphin M. Delmas.

In addition to his widow, Mrs. Lillian K. McNutt, he leaves two sons, Wallace and James McNutt. Funeral services will be conducted at 2 p.m. tomorrow at the chapel of Cunningham & O'Connor, 1031 South Grand avenue.

Roosevelt Road Conference Set

Final decision on the proposed plan to build the Roosevelt Highway through the city of Long Beach is expected to be reached October 5 at a conference of officials of the county, the city of Long Beach and the State Highway Department, according to an announcement yesterday by Supervisor Quinn, head of the road committee of the Board of Supervisors.

At present the southern terminus of the Roosevelt Highway is at Redondo Beach. The plan is to carry it on to Long Beach and through that city by way of State street and then on to Seal Beach.
