- Freestyle 1-6 or No Test thru Preliminary: 1 1/2 minutes
- Pre-Juvenile and above: 2 minutes
- Routines may be shorter

Dress Rehearsal: Dress Rehearsal is **Saturday, December 10** from **1:30 - 3:30 PM** on the Varsity Rink. You will need to be present for either the first half or the second depending on your placement in the program. Details will be forthcoming.
