We are proud that the Company has helped the Middle East take the next step toward a unified vision, and perhaps the formation of the Middle Eastern Union. Jared Kushner was keen to point out the Quantum - Trump border wall's reapplication to the West bank border wall, which is a promising initiative.

However, temporary value obstructionism has caused the U.S. government to shut down creating an impasse preventing further dialogue on subject matter. This allows the Company to review U.S. - Asian trade policy in search for more opportunity. In light of the unified vision of the Middle East gaining momentum, under the prospect of the Middle Eastern Union, this has inspired Iran to participate in the regional competition. Iran has internally debated a 'Fin Garden' initiative that will help shift its economy allowing its oil revenues to cut across the periphery of Iran stimulating growth. This reduces Iran's dependency on Strait of Hormuz giving the U.S. Treasury cause to review sanctions. However, there seems to be a value conflict of U.S. policy as it relates to the region involving Iran. The recent signing of Chabahar port deal between Iran, India, and Afghanistan in 2016 has now come into view. On one hand, the U.S. State Department has advocated for the suspension of aid to Pakistan, but also has increased Iranian sanctions through the U.S. Treasury. This policy seems to be a value contradiction similar to the U.S. government shutdown. This contradiction in U.S. policy has created a rift between neighboring India and Pakistan, leaving Pakistan to find a new trade partner with China or attack India for U.S. aid. However, China is reluctant to embrace Pakistan as a partner due to long standing regional disputes that if migrated to China could be devastating to China's developing economy, which

World War 3: India 'EVACUATES 36,000 PEOPLE' from Pakistan border to escape heavy shelling

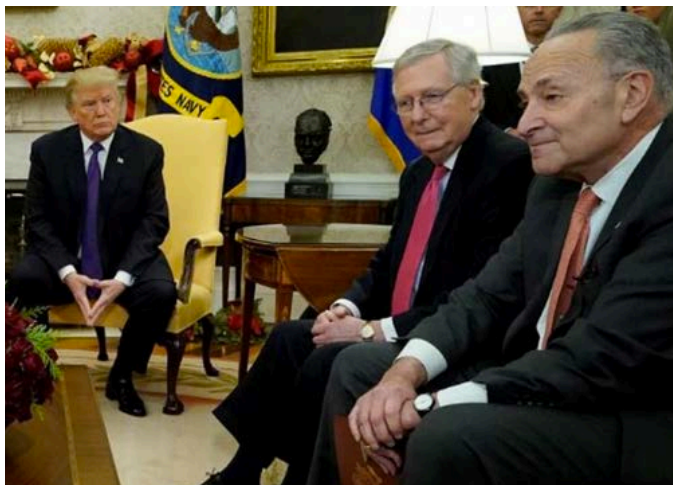

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currently does not possess the internal controls necessary to filter unwanted migratory repercussions of such a trade relationship.

Russia is unlikely to engage in the dispute due to its upcoming election in 2018 as it might tarnish President Putin's success in Syria. This creates a potential diplomatic power vacuum in the

Middle East with desperate value narratives like the U.S. government shutdown stealing oxygen from talks around the Middle Eastern Union, or Pakistan attacking India. The Company simply outlines how the value contradiction in U.S. policy with respect to Pakistan and Iran is similar to the value internals of the Securities and Exchange Commission contradicting the Department of Justice regarding the Company's transition to Quantum Corp., which warrants further transparency. Within the opacity of uncertainty lies misunderstanding that can quickly effect complex geo-political outcomes, and further clarity by Press Secretary Sanders would be most appropriate in this context. The Chabahar port has essentially cut Pakistan out of trade between India and Afghanistan, and this is now proving to have devastating effects especially when paired with the U.S. cutting aid to Pakistan. The current geo-political backdrop gives Pakistan very little option other than to attack India in order to curry favor with the U.S. for aid. The concept of the Middle Eastern Union is too new to be able to negotiate this current economic development. However, in the future Pakistan would be a member of the Middle Eastern Union where it would be able to express a value grievance such as this one to its reciprocal member states. In a future instance the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia would be keen and free to point out how the contradiction in policy places an unnecessary burden on Iran while creating the conditions for war between Pakistan and India. This type of





relationship derived through the Middle Eastern Union would play a pivotal role in helping to reshape or counter balance temporary economic disturbances that have the potential to plague the Middle East for another decade. The United Nations does

not have the time sensitive ability or bureaucratic ability to resolve such value grievances, which again provides Israel a sterling opportunity to help shape major aspects of the Middle Eastern Union.

Pakistan is resource rich in rare earth elements, but due to its increased isolation in the region it has been unable to extract new trade possibilities. Pakistan also lacks the infrastructure necessary to contribute to the current economic paradigm of technological innovation. This creates a series of problems that ultimately result in Pakistan's dependency on U.S. aid. Regardless, U.S. policy in the region is not well defined. The U.S. Treasury increasing sanctions on Iran while the U.S. Department of State cuts aid to Pakistan marginalizes any U.S. position in commodity related natural resources, and trade causing Pakistan to become isolated in the region. As the facade of positive sentiment between North and South Korea begins to fade after the Olympics taking notice of this policy contradiction could potentially play a major role in advancing the U.S. strategy of containment. This would allow the U.S. to constrain Chabahar trade through Pakistan if Iran is unable to implement its Fin Garden reforms contributing to a unified vision.

Ceding Pakistan due to overlooked departmental conflicts in policy doesn't seem to be a coordinated strategic effort by the U.S. to disrupt the region for value, but rather a policy mistake that could help the U.S. contain North Korea nuclear ambition.
