Dear friends and members of our family of faith:

Greetings to you in a month marked by the folklore of Ireland, the dawn of Spring and the heaviness of Holy Week.

In March, our family of faith will: (1) continue our Lenten sermon series on "The Way of the Cross"; (2) come together for our monthly Potluck Lunch; (3) honor Palm Sunday; (4) gather for our Sunday School Brunch; and (5) host our ecumenical Good Friday service.

On <u>March 4</u>, gathering in Miller Chapel, we will continue our Lenten journey with our third "The Way of the Cross" sermon, *Jesus Is Condemned*; contribute to our Sharing-the-Light Food Collection; participate in the Feast for All Sinners and Saints; and, share food and fellowship at our "Room at the Table" Potluck Lunch. On <u>March 11</u>, we will recall the fourth step of "The Way of the Cross," entitled *Jesus Is Denied*. On <u>March 18</u>, we walk another step on "The Way of the Cross," identified as *Jesus Is Judged*. On <u>March 25</u>, Palm Sunday, we will congregate in the sanctuary and conclude our "The Way of the Cross" sermon series with *Jesus Is Crowned*. Following worship, we will assemble in the Fellowship Hall for our annual Sunday School Brunch. On <u>March 29</u>, Holy Thursday, we are invited to join the Reformed Catholic Church to commemorate the Last Supper. On <u>March 30</u>, Good Friday, we will sponsor and present the beginning of the Community Good Friday Service in our sanctuary. The "Walk of the Cross" will be conducted down sidewalks adjacent to Main Street of Warsaw and conclude at the First United Methodist Church of Warsaw.

On Sunday, <u>March 25</u>, the F.A.C.E. (Faith And Caring Encounter) Group will assist in set-up, cook-up, eat-up and clean-up at our Sunday School Brunch. On Friday, <u>March 30</u>, F.A.C.E. Group members will participate in the "Walk of the Cross" from our sanctuary to the sanctuary of the First United Methodist Church.

As we make our way through the First Quarter of 2018, we acknowledge God's generous blessings to our faith community. We thank friends and church members who faithfully honor their promises of support. Annual revenue from our Head Start lease agreement has been received. To date, winter heating costs have moderately exceeded budgeted allotments. Thus, early in this year, we encourage all who have vowed support to honor their promises of support so that we may keep pace with seasonal expenses. Offering envelopes (weekly and monthly) are available on Sundays during the Time of Fellowship and from the Church Office during weekdays. In solidarity—as a family of faith—may we practice the principles of family, faith and future in our current season of Lent…and in all seasons.

Pastoral Sabbatical 2018: Update

As explained in this space in the February newsletter, the Pastor's Contract and Terms of Call of the Rev. Dr. Barbara Therese require that she take a three-month paid Sabbatical after serving the congregation for five years. On March 1, 2018, Rev. Barbara will have served the United Church of Warsaw for six continuous years.

Therefore, during the spring and summer of 2018, our pastor will serve a three-month Time of Clergy Renewal away from pastoral duties. During that time, pastoral responsibilities of worship leader and Moderator of Commission will be fulfilled by two Summer Ministers.

Funding for the pastor's travel, accommodations and registration fees for off-site events during the pastor's Sabbatical was secured through a comprehensive grant application to the Lilly Endowment Clergy Renewal Program in April 2017. The grant funding also covers: Pulpit Supply, Pastoral Administration, congregational events and Summer Music by the Steeple planned during the pastor's Sabbatical.

On April 22 and April 29, the two Summer Ministers will be introduced to the congregation during Sunday morning worship.

Further plans of the pastor's Sabbatical will be announced in upcoming newsletters.

The year 2018 is presenting meaningful opportunities for faith building and faith renewal for our pastor and for our family of faith!

Notes from Clerk of Commission, Lance Bush Highlights of Commission Meeting of February 12, 2018

- Church Treasurer Bob Cummins presented a strong Financial Report for start-up of 2018.
- Commission members voiced strong approval for new format of our Sunday bulletin.
- To update church membership data and to compile a new Church Directory of Members and Friends, a questionnaire will be included in the March edition of *The Connection*, our monthly newsletter. Please complete questionnaire and return it to the Church Office by March 31, 2018. Based on responses, official church membership rolls will be adjusted, and an updated Church Directory will be assembled.
- Our church will host the opening of the Good Friday Service of "The Walk of the Cross" on March 30 at 12 noon. The service will conclude, after wooden cross is carried along Main Street, at the First United Methodist Church.
- The Commission approved a proposal to form a partnership between the Warsaw Food Pantry and Warsaw Elementary School's Produce and Vegetable Garden. Under the terms of the proposed partnership, 90% of the produce and vegetables grown in the garden will be donated to the Food Pantry. In advance of the planting season and in exchange for the produce, the Food Pantry will provide necessary supplies: seeds, fertilizer, gardening tools and equipment. The Warsaw Food Pantry will apply for a grant to fund the proposed partnership.
- Reminder: Our annual May Breakfast will be held on Tuesday, May 1, beginning at sunrise, 6:07 a.m. Sign-ups for this yearly tradition will appear in early April.
- Our church will provide all food needed for dinner—main course, salad and dessert--for the monthly Free Community Meal on Wednesday, June 6, hosted at St. Michael's Catholic Church in Warsaw. In mid-April, please look for Sign-Up List to provide a dinner entree (enough to feed 12 people). Meanwhile, please speak with Linda Demers or Margaret Gardner, members of Mission Committee, for additional details.
