Today, her program spans four countries and mails over 1 million free books each month to children around the world. The Sedona Rotary Club oversees the local chapter called the "Verde Valley Imagination Library". The Badgad Core Committee oversees the chapter servicing the communities of Bagdad, Hillside & Wikieup.

These amazing workshops have been led by Rose Vasquez of *Strategic Writing and Consulting*, with over 25 years of grant writing and nonprofit leadership experience.


Reignite Your Passion
