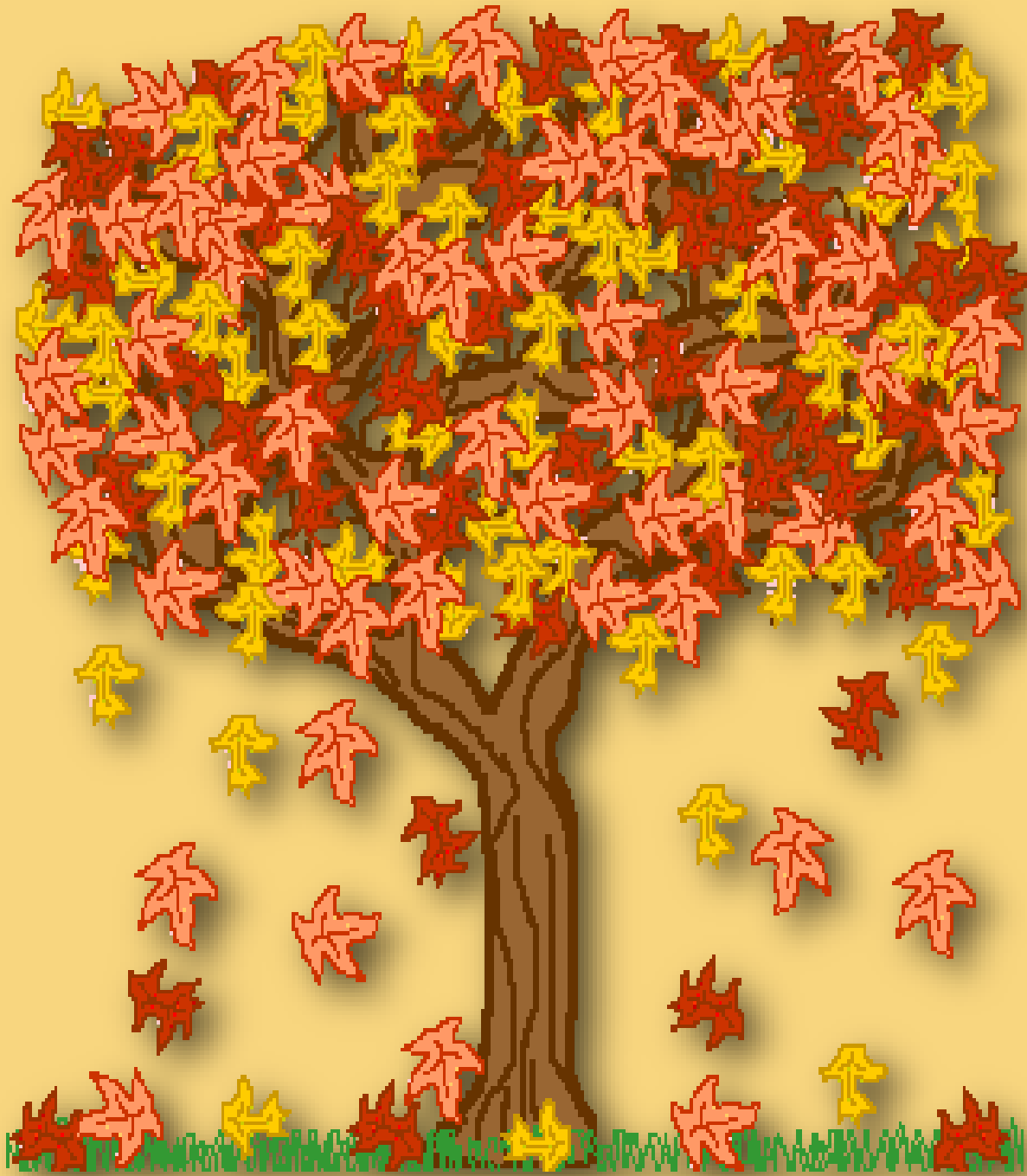

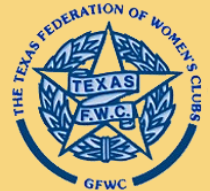

## Meet me In St.Louis!



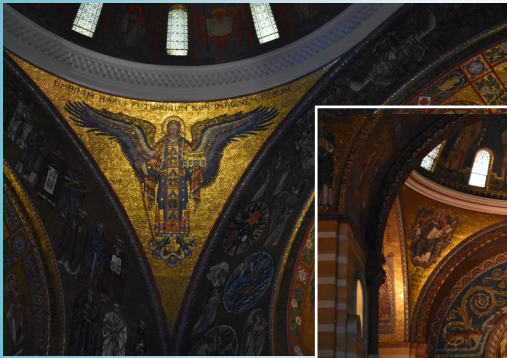

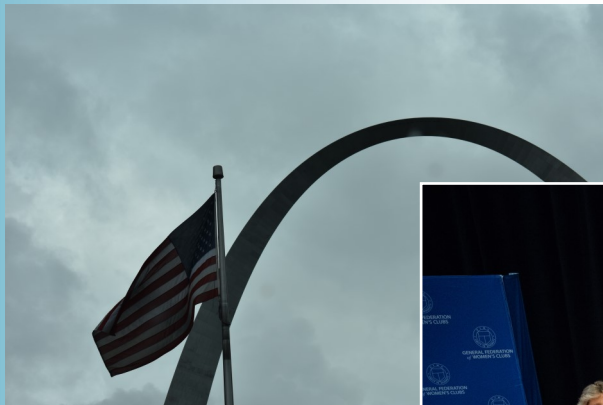

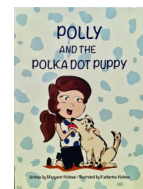
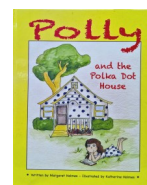


## Around the State Continued

### The Circle of the Volunteer Spirit

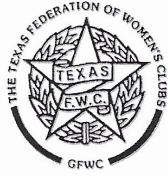
Helen Lamberth reported on the rewarding effects of the volunteer spirit. This sweet story came about as a result of the enormous amount of goodwill and money given by the federated club women of the nation in the aftermath of Hurricane Harvey. As you know, over a hundred and twenty-five thousand dollars was donated to the Hurricane Harvey relief by GFWC Club ladies of the nation. This money was sent to our state president, Patti Poe, to determine where it was best needed. Money went to various places with a reserve kept to be given to libraries in the affected area when they were ready to start to rebuild. Patti Poe, Billi Williams, Fran Mask, and Helen Lamberth delivered checks to six libraries in the stricken area. One of the libraries is the Buna Public Library of Buna, Texas. The director of the library is Essie Lee who is a sister to the current Magnolia District president, Kathy McBride. As a thank you gesture, copies of three children's books written by a local author, Margaret Holmes, were given to the group. The author of the three books is donating the proceeds from the books to the library. The circle of the volunteer spirit is apparent in the story. Club women across the nation donate money for the hurricane relief, the club women who received the donation deliver it to the affected libraries. Libraries have long been a project of the General Federation of Women's Clubs who are responsible for a large number of libraries across the nation being built. The club women delivering the relief money are given books by a local author as a thank you and now these books will be donated to other libraries. There is also a real possibility that a new club in Buna will come out of this. The volunteer spirit moves from one person to another. As Helen Lamberth said, "Everyone gives from the heart, everyone wins." and that the story shows ...'all the ways clubwomen touch each other and the lives of others and how the lives of

others touch us!"

I look forward to see all of you at our 122<sup>nd</sup> Fall Board of Directors Meeting in Austin.

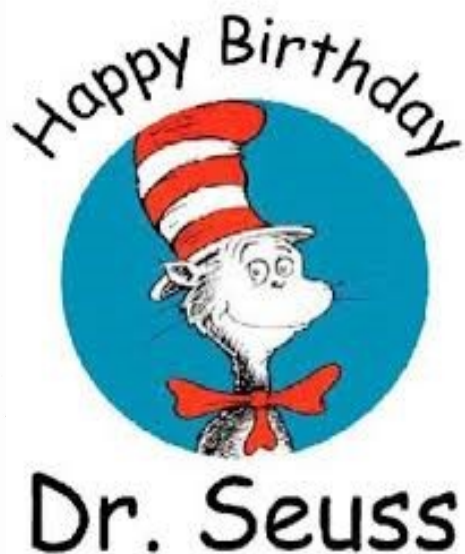
