Col A.H. Belo, instrumental in founding *The Dallas Morning News*, was named one of the first four inductees into the Texas Newspaper Foundation Hall of Fame, which recognized their service to their communities and the newspaper industry. The induction occurred as part of the winter meeting of the Texas Press Association.

Belo's first Texas newspaper was *The Galveston Daily News*. In the 1880s he joined George Bannerman Dealey in beginning *The Dallas Morning News*. Belo Corp owns 19 television stations (including WFAA), four newspapers (including *The Dallas Morning News*), two regional cable news channels, and numerous websites.

The newspaper article from which this was excerpted failed to explain the meaning of the title "Col" for Col. Belo. -Ed.
