Our speaker this month is Mark Vogl.

Mark is a graduate of Milton Hershey School, Hershey, Pennsylvania. He is a Distinguished Military Student/Graduate of THE CITADEL, THE MILITARY COLLEGE OF SOUTH CAROLINA. He graduated in 1977 with a B.S. in Education, and a concentration in military history. He was designated both a Distinguished Military Student and a Distinguished Military Graduate. Mark was commissioned into the U.S. Army as a Second Lieutenant of Infantry on commencement day and served from 1977 to 1986. His assignments included command of Company B, Third Battalion, 36th Infantry Regiment (Mechanized Infantry), and served as an Assistant Professor of Military Science at Fordham University. His awards include the Meritorious Service Medal, Army Commendation Medal, and Airborne Parachute wings. Mark has served as the National Chair for the Cold War Veterans Committee and as National Chair for the Foreign Relations and Armed Services Committee of American Veterans, (AMVETS).
