

# Candlelight Audition Information

To be eligible to perform in Candlelight on December 15<sup>th</sup> you must have: attended the recording session, attended the fall concert, paid your participation fee, filled out all paperwork from the candlelight packet (coming soon), and learned your part on the following pieces. You will receive a score for the first 7 songs listed and the top scores will be selected. **You will be scored on: Pitch accuracy, rhythmic precision, diction, intonation, and musicality.**

We will spend a small amount of time in class on these pieces, but the expectation is that you will do the majority of the work for this on your own. If you are absent on the day of a part test, it is your responsibility to make up the test before school or after school (not during class time) either before your absence or right after you return.
