Our prayers continue for family members and friends of the 49 victims in Orlando and the additional wounded as they heal from their injuries. In the midst of the violence in our society, we long for people to not add to the hatred, the blaming, the anger that is generated from such horrible acts. "Will listen With love" was launched in response to the devastating killings in Orlando. It is a national support network comprised of pastors, therapists, or trained listeners. I may not be needed but I have signed up to be a listener.

We have opened our church doors to a support group for families who struggle with caring for

mentally ill family members. We will be meeting Thursday evenings. Please hold us in prayer.

There is a sign up sheet for 2 Friday nights in July, the 15<sup>th</sup> or 29<sup>th</sup> to go to a baseball game together. We can plan on sharing an evening of baseball and fireworks!

Peace Camp in July. I will be leading 4 different days and 4 different day camps in July with a Peace theme for each of them. The first day of Peace Camp is July 19<sup>th</sup> from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. with lunch and snacks provided. The second day is July 21<sup>st</sup>, third day is July 25<sup>th</sup> and the fourth day is July 27<sup>th</sup>. If you have any interest in helping me on any of these days, please let me know and I will sign you up. I will be sending out a letter specifically with what I will may need help wise and supply wise for those days.

There are many things that happen in the background of every day life of the church. Today I had a visitor from Arizona who used to be from a small town near by. Her grandchild is in transition and this gender change has brought rejection and judgment and this grandmother wanted to find a church who would not judge. I said they would find acceptance here. These kinds of experiences are sadly not unique. Thanks be to God for Cedar Falls UCC and others who live and breathe the Gospel of Jesus and are loving and don’t judge.

Lacy Oudekerk gave her dad a gift of dance for Father’s Day. She is learning to worship God through movement. As she continues to learn and grow, please encourage her.

I am starting a confirmation class. If we have 12 year old and older students who want to be a part of this class, please let me know. Lexi Oudekerk and I will begin classes in July but will add anyone else who is interested.

We were contacted by NE Iowa Food Bank who is asking for personal hygiene items to be given out. We will be a drop off location starting in July. If you have food items for the food bank or personal hygiene items please drop them off at church.
