Peace Day Camps

Dear Family and Friends of Cedar Falls UCC,

Peace camp, 9 a.m.-3 p.m., for ages 5-12 years old, will be held on July 19, 21, 25, and 27th. We will focus on different days on different aspects of what it means to be a peacemaker. "Blessed are the peacemakers for they shall be called the children of God." (Matt. 5:9)

This first year, I am limiting registration to the first 10 children to sign up. I am asking that anyone who can volunteer to help me also sign up so we can have training or go over how the camp will work ahead of time.

I am inviting different community people to come in at different times each day to lead that unit. Example, we have one community person that has agreed on a couple of those days to lead Tai Chi.

I am looking for someone to lead yoga, someone else to do story telling, someone else willing to work with them in a art project. It could be each day of camp or just one day. Music is another tool for teaching and living "peace." We will be making our own lunch and eating as a family each of the days. If you want to help during that time, let me know.

July 15th we have 8 people signed up for a baseball game (Waterloo Bucks). I need to get the tickets this Friday (the 8th) so if you can join us let me know before I get the tickets (\$5 a ticket). July 29th is the other date to go as a church. Sign up if you can make it. These dates include fireworks!

I read in church a passage from Leviticus: “Do not mistreat foreigners who are living in your land. Treat them as you would a fellow Israelite, and love them as you love yourselves. Remember that you were once foreigners in the land of Egypt. I am the Lord your God.” (Good News version 19:33-34) Pray for all the refugees and for a peaceful resolution to all the conflicts in the world.

Our prayers continue for family members and friends of the 49 victims in Orlando and the additional wounded as they heal from their injuries. In the midst of the violence in our society, we long for people to not add to the hatred, the blaming, the anger that is generated from such horrible acts. “Will listen With love” was launched in response to the devastating killings in Orlando. It is a national support network comprised of pastors, therapists, or trained listeners. I may not be needed but I have signed up to be a listener.

We have opened our church doors to a support group for families who struggle with caring for mentally ill family members. We will be meeting Thursday evenings. Please hold us in prayer. I read an article this past week and posted it on Facebook that ranked Iowa #50 of our US states for care of the mentally ill. Saddened me greatly, are you open to changing this?

On June 29th, the Courier had an article about a woman seeking a site in this area for foster children’s clothes closet. We could look into “Kaden’s Kloset” and what that would like like.... We could start our own clothes closet for children, or we can do nothing. What are your thoughts?

We lift up Marlys and Bart McAninch, Marjorie Shaffer, Eleanor Crownfield, Cleo Cross, and Dale and Janeen Danielsen and

Marge McKinley. Anytime someone pops into your thoughts please pray for them. So we pray that God’s love may be felt and God’s light shine in and around them. God knows what they need and perhaps what we need better than any of us.

I am starting a confirmation class. If we have 12 year old and older students who want to be a part of this class, please let me know. Lexi Oudekerk and I will begin classes in July but will add anyone else who is interested.

We are making a difference where we can and how we can. You can make the church stronger. Invite and bring friends to worship. Let us know how we can reach into the community. God bless you! God is awesome! God loves you!

The estimate to fix everything is almost \$14,000. Some of these repairs are essential and need to be completed as soon as possible.
