The focus of my message in the Voice is the stewardship ministry for the upcoming year. The goal of any stewardship ministry is to give members the opportunity to make a financial commitment to the work of the congregation. Making a financial commitment is essential to church membership and growing in giving is part of our faith journey.

Please give thoughtful consideration to your pledge for 2017. This past year we have leaned heavily on our endowment fund to sustain the budget. That will continue, however, we can have a positive impact on that with our pledges. Following is the stewardship schedule for this year:

Planning Calendar – 2017 Budget
October – Assemble preliminary budget

November 13 – Pledge cards available on Sunday
Week of November 13th – Remaining pledge cards in the mail
December 11th – Pledge cards returned to the Church Council
Early January – Council prepares tentative final budget
January 8 – Tentative final budget available for review and comment
Late January – Congregation’s Annual Meeting – Final Budget approved

In the past year we have maintained many of the church activities from the past and have been able to begin new ones. We continue for example United Fellowship, Morning Circle, serving and participating in the ministry of the community meal on the 5th Tuesday. We are also doing some nice things to create more exposure for the Cedar Falls UCC. We have a new Web site and are increasing our presence on Facebook. Pastor Sue has been facilitating Theological Forums on Wednesday evenings. Pastor Janice is providing a variety of workshops. Last Saturday was: All are Welcome at the Table, but Do I have to sit next to you? There is a workshop scheduled for January and another one in February. We launched a clothes closet ministry for foster children. A goal is for us to continue to increase our exposure throughout the community in 2017.

We will be available to review and discuss the anticipated budget after church on Sundays.

The support group for families with a child diagnosed with mental illness now only meets once a month. We will be providing this support

group 6:30 p.m. on the second Thursday of each month. Our next meeting is December 8th.
