The grant money they received allowed them to buy cases of diapers to give out. 70 – 100 families were helped at that shower. This church had as its neighborhood 47% of the children living in poverty. This community shower helped so many children every year. Please consider giving to this special offering.

Cedar Falls UCC Foster Children's Closet
(Kaden's Kloset)

In November we have helped around 20 families. What a vital ministry we are providing for foster families in the Cedar Falls/ Waterloo area! We have even been reaching out to families as far north as Mason City. We have received donations from individuals and other churches for this ministry. This is a visible community outreach that is making a positive impression in the community, but even more importantly it is helping foster families and a few other families get clothes, shoes, coats, and personal items that are badly needed for the children. We need diapers all sizes.

On-going and UPCOMING EVENTS

The United Church of Christ has launched a new partnership invitation to all our churches. At the last General Synod they began the "3 Great Loves" initiative –an initiative that focuses on Love of Neighbor, Love of Children, and Love of Creation. "...And the greatest of these is love." (–a quote from 1 Corinthians 13:13) There may be no greater calling in today's ministry than the call to love. 3 Great Loves is a denomination-

wide effort that about engaging the UCC to take action and to show the impact of the UCC, working together as one church, with one voice and one vision – a vision of A Just World for All.

Our General Minister and President, John C. Dorhauer, invites us to consider supporting the 3 Great Loves initiative over the next 2 years by planning activities around the following time line for each of the Loves: 1. NOW through the Spring of 2018 – Love of Neighbor: whether it is a neighbor in need who lives next door or on the other side of the world, many are faced with the need for protection, shelter, and support. 2. Summer 2018 – Winter 2019 – Love of Children: children in many families and neighborhoods need school supplies to overcome inequalities in our education systems. 3. Spring of 2019 – Love of Creation: taking care of our environment is one of the most important responsibilities we have as the Church.
