Last Sunday I spoke about the passage in Ephesians that says we are God's handiwork or as some versions of the Bible states that we are God's work of art. How is this church God's handiwork or God's work of art? Zig Ziglar once said, "You cannot consistently perform in a manner which is inconsistent with the way you see yourself." Though the passage in Ephesians refers to followers of Christ, I think we can apply this to the church community. Can you image this church as a work of art? Can you see yourself as part of this handiwork of God?
