Church Community

Dear Family and Friends of Cedar Falls UCC,

We want to invite people to join us in community who believe in the value of all people because he or she is a child of God. We want to be the community that welcomes, loves, invites all who wants to live this out. Being small in number is our weakness and our strength is welcoming all who come into our midst. Some of those flaws I am working to improve, for I find the more I love the easier it is to challenge my flaws. I need community. I want my community to be Cedar Falls United Church of Christ. How about you?

We have so much to celebrate in life. In so many ways we are truly blessed. I have been reading many uplifting stories to continue to lift up my own story. I find focusing on stories that lift up my values are important, especially if I am having a down day. What lifts you up?
