In preparation for the 2019 budget it is apparent that the Endowment Fund will not fund the shortfall that pledges do not cover with the current budget carried forward.

We will hold a congregational meeting on Sunday September 16th at 11:30 a.m. to review the status of the Endowment Fund, impact on the 2019 budget, and review of some potential options.
