# **Being Church**

Dear Family and Friends of Cedar Falls UCC,

May we give thanks to God for this community of faith and our decision to choose "life". We are choosing life and continue as a church even if we are feeling shaky. In a book called, "Real Good Church", author Rev. Molly Phinney Baskette said there are plenty of churches out there for people "who want things to stay exactly the same, for people who hate disruption and innovation, for people who are committed to the idea of God-approved homophobia, among other things."

Church growth experts have been telling me the past couple of years that we (as a church) need to know  $1^{st}$  why we think God wants us to be a church – in other words, can we agree that we have a God blessed ministry to offer this community? If we say yes, then what can we offer that is unique and needed in this community?

Rev. Molly Phinney Baskette states that "there aren't enough ... churches that are open, welcoming, flexible, playful, and forward-moving." A couple of years ago, we put together a brochure and a web page and began focusing on being a "welcoming" congregation. We want to be a safe haven for people who want to explore their faith and we do pretty well at accepting people wherever they are in life. A question I have for us to ponder at the moment is this: We want to survive, but do we truly want to grow as a church? Are we o.k. with what it will take to grow – change, flexibility, doing things differently and perhaps out of our comfort zone?

In October, we will be having two Halloween parties. On Friday night the 26<sup>th</sup> of October will be for our children mainly. We will open it for children under 5 from 6:30 - 7:15 p.m. The older children will help host a costume contest and have activities for these children and then after they leave the older children continue with activities and their costume contest. This will go until 9 p.m. If you want to help by donating prizes (age appropriate) or candy or decorations, we will appreciate it. Our second Halloween party is specifically an outreach party for our LGBTQ youth and allies. This will be October 27<sup>th</sup>, Saturday evening: 7 p.m. - 10 p.m. This too will include a costume party, food, games and opportunities for this community to socialize and experience a welcome that doesn't judge them, but accepts them where they are. This is an outreach into our community.

We cannot compete with larger churches to offer the kind of programming that attracts young families. That doesn't mean we don't have something to offer. It does mean that we have a job to do to know what we have to offer and begin offering it with persistence and as effectively as possible. The door hangers was one of many inexpensive ideas that a church growth consultant suggested for churches with limited resources. It needs to have a simple message that will appeal to our strength – "we welcome people wherever they are on life's journey."

Together we welcome and invite others to acknowledge that all people have worth and are children of God.

Together we live out God's love for us.

Together we love God, serve Christ, and are empowered by God's Spirit to reach out to others.

Together we are the church.


