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
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
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# What OCEAN CREATURE am I?

bone.


I'd like to gobble up this tasty sea  
lion—if I can catch it.


Can you guess who I am?

I can also swim very fast, so very few get away.






## Whose **EYE** is this?

When danger threatens, I hide inside the tentacles of sea anemones.


My name sounds like I would be good at telling jokes!

The stinging tentacles of a sea anemone do not harm me. So if I hide inside them I will be safe from bigger fish that might want to eat me—just like that barracuda outside!




## **Whose FIN is that?**

Can you guess who I am?




## **A killer whale!**
