

Main Arena Event Rules

- By entering any event Exhibitors and Competitors agree to be bound by these Rules.
- The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- The Committee reserves the right to disqualify and bar any competitor who breaches these rules and require the return of any awards and prizes.
- The Committee's and/or Judge's decision is final.
- The Show is EA affiliated, the EA Nat. Show Horse Rules & Guidelines apply to all hack events.
- Classes may be varied at the Chief Steward's discretion.

Entries & Eligibility

- The Exhibitor shall ensure that the exhibit and competitor are entered & shown only in the correct classes.
- Proof of age of junior competitors will be required. Please have valid proof of age available for rider classes. (E.g. Student Card or copy of Birth Certificate).
- Proof of horses' height may be requested. Please have height certificates available. Horses may be measured for height at the Chief Steward's discretion.
- A Competitor or Exhibitor shall not exhibit under a Judge when they or the exhibit are ineligible. Proof of eligibility such as age, height, and breed registration shall be produced on demand.
- Nominations for horse events will be by Ticket Entry purchased on the day.
- Exhibitors and Competitors are only eligible to compete if they have paid the Show Gate Fee, event entry fees and relevant camping fees.
- There will be no refund on entry fees for missed classes.
- A Maiden is a horse that has not won a first prize in a similar event at an affiliated show.
- A Novice is a horse that has not won a Championship at; any Agricultural Show, or a Championship at an EA affiliated show or has not won a first at a Royal Show.
- Stallions are not permitted in ridden Hack classes.
- Stallions are eligible for all led classes, western and working horse classes.
- A Galloway Hack shall be over 14 hands and not exceed 15 hands.
- Horses competing in specific breed classes must be registered with their respective breed society and proof of registration and current membership must be produced on demand.
- Horses competing in "Any Other Breed" classes need not be registered.
- "Any Other Breed" classes are only for horses not eligible to enter in another breed class.

<u>Judges</u>

• No competitor shall approach a Judge who is officiating unless they first obtain permission from the Chief Steward. There will be no fraternization between the Exhibitor or Competitor and the Judge during the course of the show.

Drug Abuse

• All horses must present for competition drug free. The Show Society may carry out random testing for drugs in horses. All costs incurred for testing shall be borne by the exhibitor where the test result is positive for an inappropriate substance.

Safety and Apparel

- All riders must wear protective head-gear to the current Australian Standard 3838 or better whilst riding anywhere on the show grounds. The helmet retaining harness must be secured and fastened at all times that the rider is on the horse.
- All riders must wear suitable riding boots that are heeled and soled, with little or no tread, at all times when riding anywhere on the show grounds.
- No person under the age of 17 years is to handle a stallion.
- Riders under the age of 18 years are not permitted to wear top boots, gaiters or chapettes in riding classes.
- Electric fences are only allowed in designated areas and must be sign posted.

Please follow the progress of the program closely. Judges will move through the events quickly to keep all rings to the timetable. Competitors please move unobtrusively into the ring to be ready for your event when the ribbons are being awarded for the previous event.

Competitors please be on time and prepared for your events and eligible championships. All second place-getters must be standing-by ready to compete for Reserve Champion; the rings will not wait if you are not ready. No ring events shall be obliged to wait for a competitor. This will be at the Chief Steward's discretion. If there is a clash of events between the led and ridden horse arenas the led ring will be asked to wait.

Time Trial

Course

1. Start course at Start / Finish Pegs

4. Bend through pegs starting with first peg on your right

5. Proceed to drum 'B' making a clockwise turn around drum

6. Proceed to drum 'C' making an anti-clockwise turn around drum


7. Proceed to drum 'D' making an anti-clockwise turn around drum

Rules

- Knocking over a drum or peg will result in a 5 second penalty per drum / peg.
 - If flag is dropped rider must dismount, pick up flag, remount and can then continue course.
 - 3. Error of course will result in elimination.



Giant Pumpkin Growing Tips:

- Plant your Atlantic Giant Pumpkin (*Cucurbita maxima*) seed in late Spring.
- Your pumpkin patch should be well drained, spacious and sunny but well protected. The ground should be prepared and turned with manure or other types of food to give nourishment and compost.
- Be sure to fertilise and water regularly but don't over water as it may rot. Your pumpkin has a lot of growing to do, so fertilise weekly with liquid manure or liquid compost.
- Once established, prune back your vine to one fruit.
- A giant pumpkin takes approximately five months to grow about 70-90 days before fruit appears on the vine and another 60 days or so for the fruit to mature.
- The fruit matures in Autumn just in time for the Caves Country Show!!
