Owners Corp AGM Financial Update

SC treasurer, Derek Dryden, reported to this month's meeting that the strata's finances were in good shape.

The administrative fund has a balance of \$281,961 which reflects the fact that we have had two levy payments and just four months of expenditure. (Our financial year runs from 1st February). We have incurred no unusual expense items and all the major expense categories are well within budget.

Our outstanding levies are also tracking well, with only three owners who have not paid their levies for February. These owners can expect a knock at their door very soon.

ERKO presence in the Solomon Islands

ERKO resident Terry Liddicott has been in Honiara for 11 months working for the Ministry of Education through Australian Volunteers International (AVI), assisting school finances – not an easy project with 70% of schools with no power or computer equipment, and the rest with Excel based systems, but low levels of computer literacy.

On a lighter note Terry was guest-of-honour and speaker at a school graduation, where the Honiara City Council mayor failed to show.





How Erskineville Got Its Name

Erskineville was named after *Erskine Villa*, home of the Reverend George Erskine. After a few changes of owners the property was eventually left to the Church of England, becoming the rectory for the Holy Trinity Church at Macdonaldtown, since demolished.

Subsequently Macdonaldtown was renamed the Borough of Erskineville.

Completion of Bylaw Review

The Strata Management Act effective the end of November 2016, required all strata schemes to review their existing by-laws and submit a comprehensive by-laws list for registration. SC member Doug Turner has put in extensive time, effort and legal expertise to complete this project, providing the Owners Corporation with significant savings in legal costs for the drafting and re-writing of by-laws passed by the AGM.

The Strata Committee now has a defined grievance/complaint handling process ensuring owners/residents and their guests have an avenue to raise and respond to concerns regarding the operations and implementation of Erko by-laws. The Strata Committee is also guided by its own Code of Conduct.
