Planter Boxes | Gardens | Grass Areas - Feel free to water as many plants as you can to help keep them healthy!

Planter boxes attached to apartments on ground level (level 1) must be cared for by the resident. For example: if plants die, the owner must replace them. The grass on Bridge and Macdonald Streets is owned and maintained by City of Sydney Council. Most other garden areas are the responsibility of the Strata. We hope you enjoy them all.

Consideration for your neighbours

Sometimes there can be problems between neighbours. The By-laws explain residents' responsibilities (see 'Documents' on the Erko Apartments website). If you have concerns, stay calm and talk to your neighbour, or seek help from the Building Manager.

You are permitted to keep 1 cat / fish / bird or small dog as described in the By-laws. You need to keep your animal under control, well behaved and quiet. Be sure to clean up after your animal so everyone can enjoy the Erko surrounds.

Rubbish

Flatten and compact all rubbish as much as possible, as the number of bins is limited.

Put unwanted furniture, kitchenware, electrical items, etc in the <u>Garbage Holding Room</u> near the loading dock on level 1 – it's also called 'The Room of Unlimited Magical Recycling Possibilities'.

Plumbing

Do not flush sanitary products, rubbish or 'wipes' down your toilet. They cause blockages and can flood the bathroom. The blockages can also affect your neighbours by creating noise in the pipes.

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Building Appearance and Works

In general, keep your area tidy and don't hang items from your balcony rail.

Remember that parts of your balcony, ceiling or walls may be 'Common Property', so check with the Building Manager if you are contemplating work such as alterations or installations.

Theft - this is a very safe area, but the usual cautions apply.

Do not store valuable items in basement cages – despite our vigilance and cameras, thieves can break into storage areas.

Identity theft is a growing problem, so keep files and personal papers within your apartment. Protect yourself (and avoid waste) by receiving bills, etc by email.

Parking Spaces

There are some rules around use of and storage within parking spaces – some of these relate to State and Council law, so check the Erko By-Laws.

Visitor Parking

It's for visitors, of course, and not for use by Owners or Occupiers.

Visitors must not park in the Visitor Car Parking Space for a continuous period of time exceeding 24 hours. Clamping/removal fees will be charged to the apartment owner.

If Lifts Are Out-Of-Order (Levels 2-8)

Call SCHINDLER LIFTS 131 876 (24hrs). Alternate access is via the Fire Stairs. If you do not have a <u>Fire Stair key</u>, arrange a collection time with the Building Manager.

Strata Committee

The Strata Committee is made up of volunteers who act on behalf of and at request of owners and residents. See the website for contact details, Code of Conduct and By-laws.
