## Article 50 extension to go back to the people

Dear Mr Tusk,

We are a network of over 170 pro-EU grassroots groups in the UK, and we are writing to you on a matter of some urgency. We are referring to the question of an extension to the Article 50 notification period, following the European Council's response to our Prime Minister's request last week, and we'd like to thank you for your supportive words in the European Parliament this morning.

The European Council is charged with a momentous decision for the whole European Union and its citizens, but particularly crucial for our country and the future prosperity and happiness of its 66 million people. At the moment we are European citizens: as such we appeal to you to protect and help us. Safeguarding of citizens' rights and freedoms, security and economic well-being for all must be the priority. It is vital that we now find a way out of this disastrous chaos and resolve the crisis before further harm is done.

We clearly need an extension to the Article 50 notification period. However, we do not support a short extension to 22 May as per the European Council's offer. It is not in our interests. The UK parliament has twice rejected the Withdrawal Agreement. We do not want this agreement nor Brexit in any form.

It is time for a reframing of the narrative. We represent a large and passionate pro-EU movement in towns and cities across England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland. We are campaigning on the frontline against the dark forces that seek to disrupt democracy in Europe. We believe that our interests coincide with those of Europe. And we believe we can win.

We are confident that the UK has changed its mind and that our Prime Minister's position no longer represents a majority view of the British people. Over a million people marched in London last Sunday to tell the government that they want to stay in the EU. The decision to issue the Article 50 notification was taken by the Prime Minister without reference to impact assessments, and in the knowledge of illegality, foreign interference and allegations of criminality in the 2016 referendum. If the UK leaves on 12 April it would be a forced exit.

We support an extension which binds in the requirement for a new event or political process and is of sufficient length to enable the matter to be put to the people, with an option to remain in the EU. We believe the earliest opportunity to hold a new vote will be mid-autumn of this year. The maximum length of extension would be to the end of next year. We understand that this means running the European Parliament elections; we support this, and we appeal to you to safeguard our right to representation.

We additionally draw your attention to a petition to revoke the Article 50 notification now, which has gathered almost 6 million signatures.
