

## **Chapter 21**

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**Part 1****Street Openings and Cuts****§21-101. General.**

In accordance with the provisions of §2322 of the Second Class Township Code, 53 P.S. §67322, no railroad or street railway shall hereafter be constructed upon any Township road, nor shall any railroad or street railway crossings, nor any gas pipe, water pipe, electric conduits, or other piping, be laid upon or in, nor shall any telephone, telegraph, or electric light or power poles, or any coal tipples or any other obstructions be erected upon or in, any portion of a Township road except under such conditions, restrictions, and regulations relating to the installation and maintenance thereof, as may be prescribed in permits granted by the Township for such purpose.

**§21-102. Application for Permit.**

The application for a permit shall be on a form prescribed by the Township and submitted to the Township in triplicate. The application shall be accompanied by a fee in accordance with the schedule of fees set forth by the Department of Transportation, for highway occupancy permits and restoration charges. In addition, the applicant shall submit three copies of a sketch showing such dimensions as the location of the intended facility, width of the traveled roadway, right-of-way lines, and a dimension to the nearest intersecting street.

**§21-103. Issuance of Permit.**

A permit shall be issued to the applicant after all the aforementioned requirements have been filed.

**§21-104. Written Notice of Completion.**

Upon completion of the work, the applicant shall give written notice thereof to the Township.

**§21-105. Inspection and Compliance.**

Upon completion of the work authorized by the permit, the Township shall inspect the work and, when necessary, enforce compliance with the conditions, restrictions, and regulations prescribed by the permit. Where any settlement or defect in the work occurs, if the applicant shall fail to rectify any such settlement or other defect, within 60 days after written notice from the Township to do so, the Township may do the work and shall impose upon the applicant the cost thereof, together with an additional 20 percent of such cost.

**§21-106. Fines and Penalties.**

Any person, firm, or corporation who shall violate any provision of this Part, upon conviction thereof in an action brought before a magisterial district judge in the manner provided for the enforcement of summary offenses under the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$1,000 plus costs and, in default of payment of said fine and costs, to a term of imprisonment not to exceed 90 days. Each day that a violation of this Part continues or each Section of this Part which shall be found to have been violated shall constitute a separate offense.

Under the subject to all the conditions, restrictions, and regulations prescribed by the Township and on the general provisions and specifications, a true copy whereof is attached and made a part hercof, with the same force and effect as if written or printed herein and under and subject to the special conditions, restrictions, and regulations hereinafter set forth.

**FOR OUR CONVENIENCE, PLEASE STAKE OR MARK WHERE ROAD IS TO CONNECT TO TOWNSHIP ROAD**

The terms and conditions embodied in this permit require the permittee to complete this work by the date specified in the permit. Where permittee fails to comply with the condition as to completion of work by the time specified, the following rules will govern.

- A. Failure to start work by date specified for completions. Permit will be canceled unless permittee desires an extension of time in which case a supplemental permit may be issued.
- B. Work started and not completed by specified date. Permittee will notify Township, prior to expiration of allotted time of inability to complete the work on or before the date specified and request an extension of time. Such request shall be accompanied by the prescribed fee.
- C. Permittee not desirous of carrying out proposed work on account of change in conditions affecting. Permittee will notify the Township to the date specified for completion that work will not be carried forward, returning the permit with such notice. The fee for inspection of the work will be refunded by the Township, provided that they have been notified of cancellation prior to the expiration date.

The fees to be paid under the conditions in (a), (b) and (c) apply only to permits for which fees are collection in accordance with the fixed schedule.

All notices relative to time extension or cancellations shall be forwarded to the Township which issued the original permit.

All paved streets and roads must be cut before digging. Temporary repairs to be maintained for a period of 6 months. :  
Temporary Area of restoration must be tamped every 6" at a time with 2A stone. Surface to be 2" of cold patch material.

After 6 months, as needed to settle, Final restoration of 4" of 25 mm base ( BCBC Base ) must be put down with 1 1/2" to 2" of 9.5 mm (wearing course). Material for anything 9 sq ft or less ,but still 6" deep, 12 1/2 mm can be used The edges of the cut will then be covered with seal oil.

**Contact the Cambria Township Municipal Building for a open ditch inspection for any road occupancy permit. If the Township is not notified for the inspection, a \$200.00 inspection and coring fee will be charged-no exceptions.**

Where a pipe is required by the Supervisors for private driveways entering onto a Township Raad, the following are the requirements.

- Types of pipe-minimum of 15" pipe (unless otherwise specified by the Supervisors) meeting AASHTO Standards
- a. Polyethylene Corrugated exterior with smooth wall interior or better
  - b. PennDot approved reinforced concrete pipe or better
  - c. Polymer-coated corrugated metal pipe or better

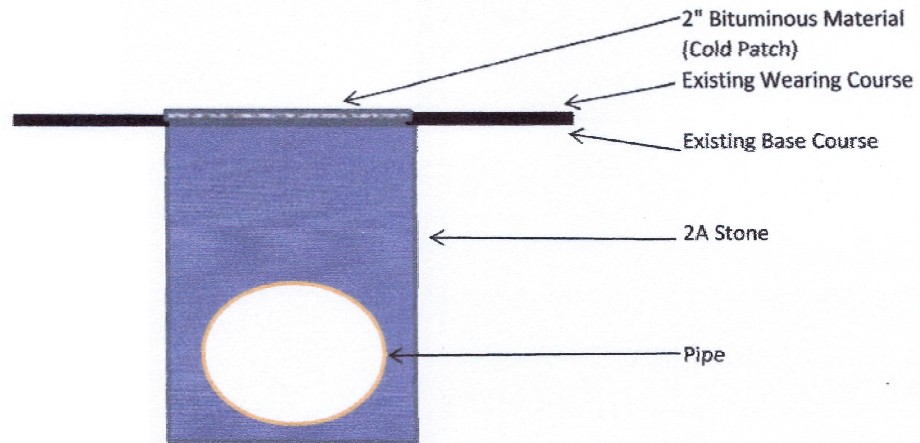

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**Part 2****Road Obstructions Prohibited****§21-201. Depositing Debris Prohibited.**

Any persons or entities, including any owners, occupants, tenants, or persons acting under the direction of or under the authorization of such persons or entities, are prohibited from depositing, or causing to be deposited, any snow, ice, slush, dirt, mud, trees or parts of trees, or any other debris, or combination thereof, (obtained from any place) on any public road, street, highway, or alley in the Township.

**§21-202. Fines and Penalties.**

Any persons or entities, including any owners, occupants, tenants, or persons acting under the direction of or under the authorization of such persons or entities, who deposit or cause to be deposited any snow, ice, slush, dirt, mud, trees or parts of trees, or any other debris, or combination thereof, on any public road, street, highway, or alley in the Township who shall violate any provision of this Part, upon conviction thereof in an action brought before a magisterial district judge in the manner provided for the enforcement of summary offenses under the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$1,000 plus costs and, in default of payment of said fine and costs, to a term of imprisonment not to exceed 90 days. Each day that a violation of this Part continues or each Section of this Part which shall be found to have been violated shall constitute a separate offense.

**§21-203. Duty of Township Supervisors.**

Nothing contained in this Part shall limit the Supervisors of the Township from taking any other action at law and/or in equity and/or under any statutory law, which may be necessary in order to abate any obstruction or nuisance, after having given reasonable notice to the person or entity causing the existence of such obstruction relative to the necessity as to removal of same.

**§21-204. Compliance.**

This Part is adopted in conjunction with and as a supplement to §2326 of the Second Class Township Code, 53 P.S. §67326, and shall take effect 10 days after its adoption.
