ORDINANCE NO. 2011- 206-C

AN ORDINANCE OF CAMBRIA TOWNSHIP, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE CAMBRIA TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE (ORDINANCE NO. 210 OF 2011) BY AMENDING ARTICLE VII SIGNS, BY AMENDING SECTION 707 OF ARTICLE VII PROHIBITED SIGNS TO INCLUDE OFF PREMISES SIGNAGE.

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Cambria, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

**SECTION 1.**

Article VII, PROHIBITED SIGNS of the Cambria Township Zoning Ordinance, Ordinance No. 210 of 2011, is hereby amended by altering section 707 PROHIBITED SIGNS, to read in its entirety as follows:

**SECTION 707. PROHIBITED SIGNS**


- (A). All signs that are not expressly permitted under this Ordinance are prohibited in the Township.
- (B). Off Premises Signage – Subject to Section 702 - Signs not located on the Premises of the business or industry which they advertise shall be permitted only in the following districts MX-VC (Mixed Village Commercial), C-G (General Commercial), C-H (Highway Commercial), I-L (Light Industrial), I-H (Heavy Industrial), O-C (Open Space), A (Agricultural), provided they are in compliance with all signage regulations as set forth as to the particular district where the sign is to be located.


**SECTION 2.**


