	<p>Reason for request The existing uniforms were purchased in 2005 when the school band comprised grades 5, 6 and 7. As a result, most of the current music uniforms are size 12 and 14s. However, the band now comprises grades 3, 4, 5 and 6. As a result, there are not enough size 8 and 10 uniforms for the younger children. At our last music competition 28 children had to wear a larger size. The School is competing in Brisbane Festival competition in October at which time 23 Grade 3 students will participate for the first time. As a result, there will be 51 children having to wear a larger size, with approximately 15 having to wear 2 sizes larger. In addition, as the uniforms are now 13 years old, many shirts are stained and they are looking quite tired.</p> <p>Design for Shirt The music teachers have designed the shirt in consultation with Belinda Fox (parent in charge of music uniform hire this year) and Heather (Tudor supplier). The teacher will confirm their preferred design this week.</p> <p>Music Pants We have sourced black formal pants at Target. We will seek to find cheaper alternatives but if not available, then we propose to purchase the pants at Target.</p> <p>Recoup Cost It is intended to hire the shirts at \$ 5 per event that the children participate in. There is also the option of offering the shirt for sale.</p> <p>Roadblocks Need to decide (in consultation with school and music teachers) if the shirts should be sold to parents to be worn as part of day to day uniform (like the interschool sports polo). Logistics of collecting the hire fees needs to be sorted out.</p>
