Important Update

Water off January 24th

Thursday January 24th is the first time we will turn off the 8" main that delivers 80% of our water. You need to expect low pressure to no water from 7am through most of the day.

Services in the Wallace and Zena Rd areas will mostly be unaffected.

Boil water for 48 hours.

What To Expect

There will be two times the water is turned off. The first is expected to be 5-8 hours. The second will be 6 to 12+ hours.

The cluster of people around the intersection of Highway 99 and Bethel Road, you will experience 100% water off.

The entire system may experience low pressure. <u>We will be issuing a</u> <u>temporary boil water notice both</u> <u>times.</u>

Sign up for Flash Alerts, this is an app for Android and iPhones.

Temporary Boil Water Notices are coming

The first notice is January 24th. The second notice is expected one to three weeks later.

What happens with a boil water notice?

- You need to boil water for drinking and cooking, probably for 72 hours.
- DO NOT DRINK THE WATER WITHOUT BOILING IT FIRST. Bring all water to a boil, let it boil for three (3) minutes, and let it cool before using, or use bottled water. Boiled or bottled water should be used for drinking, making ice, brushing teeth, washing dishes, and food preparation. Boiling kills bacteria and other organisms in the water.
- PDWA will sample water for the laboratory to test. This takes one day. We will issue an all clear or keep boiling your water notice via Facebook, Flash Alert (download the app), our website.

Why No Water?

There are disconnect and reconnection points that need to be done from old to new valves and pipes.

There are many variables with a job like this. It is difficult to know how everything will go together even with lots of planning and review before starting the move.

Our goal is to make this as short as possible. However, you should plan on 24 hours and if the reconnection does not go well it could be longer.
