For close to thirty years the founders of the Cornwall School of Mystery and Magick have been sharing their understandings of the esoteric, mystical and magickal traditions. Late in 2013 they decided to bring their respective knowledge, experience and energies together to form the School.

Driven by the desire to offer all those who were interested a way of exploring mystical and magical teachings within an ethical framework, and provide a learning structure for beginners, intermediate and advanced practitioners of the esoteric arts.

From the outset it must be understood that the School of Mystery and Magick HAS NOT been established to promote any single tradition or approach over another. In many ways esoteric and magickal truths are personal and all any course of instruction can do is offer signposts, ideas which can be challenged and guidance.

It was this gift which directed his attention to serious texts on magic, the esoteric and mystery traditions, He is a third degree Wiccan (Alexandrian tradition); a member of the British Order of Druids, B.O.T.A., and a Knight within the Ancient and Noble Order of Knights Templar and 6th Degree Arch Druid (RDG).

Alan has been leading talks and workshops for twenty years or more on a wider range of esoteric subjects, He is an NLP Trainer and Reiki Master and his interest in transpersonal counselling and therapy allows him to explore the bridge between objective and subjective experience, A PhD in Psychology supports his work in therapy and his background in wicca, shamanism and ritual magic give a somewhat different perspective to his particular approach.
