9-1-1 Heroes Award Program Awarded on April 16, 2018 Paragon Resort & Casino Marksville, Louisiana

Purpose:

It is a significant accomplishment to the recipient of this award and I encourage every agency to submit a nomination. The primary purpose of the Louisiana APCO and NENA 9-1-1 Heroes Award program is to recognize and reward an individual Telecommunicator in recognition of their exemplary handling of a specific 9-1-1 emergency call for assistance. Consideration is given to skills and knowledge exhibited in communications and leadership and the ability to respond to unusual or special circumstances.

Criteria for Telecommunicator – Line Supervisor – Center Director:

- 1. Heroic event must be ongoing or have occurred during the period January 1, 2017 December 31, 2017.
- 2. The call must have been an emergency event.
- 3. He or she must have performed some heroic action in the course of the emergency that contributed to:
 - Saving a life.
 - Significantly reducing property loss.
 - Apprehending a criminal and or stopping a crime.
 - Actions which reflect service beyond the call of duty.
 - Commendable handling and control during the emergency.
- 4. The agency submitting the nomination should complete the hero nomination form, including a summary of the incident/event. An audio recording of the 9-1-1 call, news media articles must accompany the nomination form. All nomination information must be typed, not hand written. Please include a 4" x 6" photo of your nominee, preferably in agency uniform.
- 5. It will be the responsibility of the nominating agency to contact the nominee and agency dignitaries and invite them to the awards banquet. The nominee receiving the award must be available for an interview by the committee prior to the banquet. Preferably the night before. For interview, please contact Don Smith at 318-245-2859.
